Mad Monster Murals - *Painting/Drawing* - Group Activity - Students work in small groups to invent their very own crazy monster, using paints, charcoal, and pastels. This is a busy, fun activity allowing students to work on a large scale, work as a team, and use a variety of media. Children will be examining pattern and colour. End results are always impressive, and are great for bright displays in the classroom.

Puzzle Portraits (Year 1 Only) - *Painting/Drawing* - Group Activity - These large scale portraits will create a vibrant and exciting classroom display. Working in groups, students will be taught facial proportions, and how to use a range of 2D media including pastels and charcoal. Concepts including line, shape and colour will be explored.

Shape Colour Pattern - *Printmaking* - Another RAW Art favourite. Looking at pattern, line, colour and shape, students design and make their own stencil, and are then shown how to print and mount their designs. Children learn the basics of Printmaking, while using new and fun resources. Results are vibrant and colourful.

NEW

Under the Sea - *Painting/Drawing* - students will create their very own vibrant and colourful sea-creature art work using paints, pastels and charcoal. Students will explore colour, pattern, shape and line. A busy and ultra-fun activity!

Making Moving Mobiles - *Sculpture* - using a wide range of different 2D and 3D media, students will use their imagination to create a range of interesting and creative shapes, which will then be used to make a groovy moving mobile. Students will discover shape, colour, pattern, texture and balance. An awesome introduction to sculpture!

Texture Windows - *Mixed Media* - using a range of different types of 2D media, students will be working towards creating four different texture backgrounds. Students will then work at incorporating positive and negative shapes into their design, to create an awesome window of shape, colour and texture. Learn about a wide range of concepts while having lots of creative fun!

Little Pot Monsters - *Ceramics/Sculpture* - an awesome clay activity with students learning about 3D sculpture and the properties of clay. Using a Pinch Pot as a base, and a range of natural found objects, and some fun plastic bits and pieces too, students will be making and creating their very own little 3D monster. Students will also be taken through a great simple process of preserving their little sculptures.

New Crazy Collagraphs - *Printmaking* - New and Improved - an old RAW Art favourite which we have revamped with some new printmaking resources. Students still make an awesome Print Block, and are then learn the fun process of printing their block and mounting their designs. Results are fantastic, and students experience the basics of Printmaking.

Year 1/2

Amazing Abstract Art - *Painting* - Students will discover a whole range of new concepts and media in this excellent step by step 2D painting activity. Students will learn about warm and cool colours, and positive and negative space, while using shape, line and pattern to create their abstract masterpieces. Results are sure to impress!!

Tribal Masks - *Ceramics/Sculpture* - Looking at various masks from different cultures, and their use of pattern and shape, students will work at creating their very own groovy tribal mask. Using clay to model and construct their mask, children will learn about the properties of clay, and also about sculpture, pattern, symmetry and assemblage. This is a fantastic tactile activity, with a problem solving focus.

Sensational Spiders - *Painting/Drawing* - Individual or Group activity - a fun vibrant activity which always achieves bold brilliant results. Students use pastels, charcoal and various painting techniques, and will learn about spiders while creating their very own spider artwork. Concepts such as symmetry, pattern, colour and contrast will be explored.

NEW

Flippin' Fish Fun - *Ceramics/Sculpture* - students will be creating a fantastic fish tile, exploring texture, pattern and design. A great way to learn about 3D sculpture while exploring the properties of clay. Loads of flippin' fun!

Awesome Aussie Birds - *Mixed Media* - Group Activity - students will be working in groups of 4 -5 students, working on a large scale to create their awesome vibrant Bird masterpieces. Students will be using a range of fun 2D media including paints, charcoal, pastels, and collage, while learning about Australian Birds. Results fantastic!

Mythical Creatures - *Painting/Drawing* - students will be designing and creating their very own mythical creatures. Using a range of 2D media including crayon batik, and metallic paints, and working on an extra large scale, students will love their fantasy designs.

Cool Print Block Creations - *Printmaking* - students will be making their own simple print blocks using cardboard and string, and will then be taken through the process of printing and mounting their finished designs. This is a fun, busy lesson, which achieves awesome results. A great way to learn about line, shape, colour, pattern, and also the basics of printmaking. Fun Fun Fun!

Funky Four Legged Friends - *Sculpture* - the return of an old RAW Art favourite! This is an excellent sculpture activity with students creating their very own four-legged imaginative and creative 3D creature. Students use a range of both 2D and 3D media, incorporating painting and collage, and learn about construction, assemblage and symmetry.

Year 3/4

Mix Media Madness - *Mixed Media* - This is a fun drawing/ collage activity with a varied range of unique creative outcomes. Students are taken through a step by step lesson, using a range of 2D and collage media, learning about abstraction and colour theory.

Photo Resist - *Photography* - Using an exciting series of chemical processes students will explore a different way of creating pattern and texture in an artwork. Using photographic paper and chemicals students will focus on positive and negative space, contrast, and texture.

Picasso Heads - *Painting/Drawing* - Group or Individual activity - Another of RAW Arts most popular art activities. We have been conducting this lesson in schools for over 10 years, and it always achieves excellent results. Students enjoy learning about the vibrant work of Pablo Picasso. Using his images as inspiration, children create their own masterpieces of bold, crazy Picasso portraits. A range of drawing and painting media will be used.

NEW

Mad Heads - *Ceramics/Sculpture* - a fantastic 3D sculpture activity. Students are taken through a step by step process of constructing and modeling a head, neck and shoulders of a person, which they can then turn into whatever character they would like!. A great way to discover the properties of clay, with students creating imaginative and creative Mad Heads.

Screen Printing Funky Opposites - *Printmaking* - students learn to create a simple nature stencil design. We then use both the positive and negative shapes to print onto groovy pattern paper. Students learn the step by step process of screenprinting to create their funky opposites. A great lesson which achieves excellent results.

Junky Dream Webs - *Mixed Media/ Sculpture* - students learn how to recycle industrial and domestic plastic waste into fantastic funky junky dream web inspired sculptures. A great way to explore new media, while discovering the basics of sculpture. These dream webs will look awesome hanging on display in your classroom!

Mini Monster Soft Sculpture - *Sculpture* - This year classes can experience our awesome Monster Soft Sculpture lesson on an individual scale, with students making their very own 3D monster creature. Students create templates to trace and cut out their monsters body, arms, legs, and tail. They then work at assembling all of the pieces to together to construct and make their little creatures, and decorate in various creative ways using a wide range of soft 2D media.

Exploring and Drawing Faces - *Drawing/Painting* - using a monochromatic colour scheme, students will be taken through the steps of drawing a face, learning the proportions and tonal variations of drawing faces. Students will explore a wide range of 2D media including charcoal, pastels and ink, and will be working on a large scale to create their fantastic face masterpieces.



Year 5/6

Who is Hundertwasser? - *Painting/Drawing* - looking at the fantastic vibrant work of Austrian artist Friedensreich Hundertwasser; students will be creating their very own Hundertwasser style painting of a cityscape. Using various types of 2D media including crayons, pastels and paints, students will be learning how to build up layers and blocks of colour to make a unique and creative cityscape masterpiece.

NEW

Fill a Head - *Mixed Media* - using 'Surrealism' as inspiration, students will create an illustrative drawing and collage. Using a range of different 2D media including pens and inks, students will need to 'fill a head' with an imaginative and surreal design of their choice. Students will be finally cutting out their heads to make a vibrant and interesting finished art piece ready to hang around the classroom.

NEW

Graffiti Street Art - *Mixed Media* - Group Activity – looking at street art and Graffiti style art work, students will be working in teams of 4-5 to create their own large scale street art design. Students will work at creating a groovy graffiti background, and will then be creating a stylized image of a person which will become the focus of their completed art work. Students will love their awesome Graffiti Street Art posters, and will be fantastic for classroom display.

Looking @ Op Art – using the great 'Op Art' movement of the 1960's as inspiration, students will be examining the optical illusion aspect of artmaking. Classes have two different options for their Op Art activity -

NEW

Op Art 2D Designs - *Mixed Media* – students will be creating two different style of Op Art style works. One using paper and card to create a relief–style artwork focusing on shape, colour, pattern and symmetry. The second artwork will be incorporating a simple monoprint, and will focus on the use of line.

NEW

Funky Op Art Mobiles - *Sculpture* - students will be shown how to use a range of 2D media to create 3D geometric shapes. These shapes will then be pieced together to create a groovy hanging mobile.

Looking @ Pop Art - using the great 'Pop Art' movement of the 1960's as inspiration, students will explore their use of colour and repetition. Classes have two different options for their Pop Art activity -

NEW

Pop Food Prints - *Printmaking* - Students explore one of the most popular types of media used throughout the Pop Art movement. Using Food as the theme for this activity, students will be learning about Reduction Printing using printfoam.

Pop Art Murals - *Mixed Media* - Group Activity - working on a large scale, and in small groups, students will be working within a grid format, looking at repetition of various images. Using a range of mixed media including templates, newspaper, pattern paper, paints, printmaking, students' will be trying different techniques and effects. Students will be looking at the work of various Pop artists such as Andy Warhol for inspiration.

Looking @ Ceramics - Classes have two different types of Ceramic activities to choose from - one that is decorative and one that is functional.

NEW

Clay Picasso Faces - *Sculpture* - a great way to discover the work of Picasso, while learning about clay and 3D sculpture. Students will be creating a Picasso-style face, starting from a slab base, and then using clay in different ways to make the various features.

NEW

Pottery through the Ages - *Ceramics* - students will be examining how people have been using clay since the beginning of time. Using the Pinch Pot as a base, students will be taken through various ways of turning this simple shape into an interesting, creative, functional art piece.
