We have a fun range of activities to choose from for each year level, which are based on our popular in-schools program that we have been running in schools for the past 15 years.

5/6 Years

Funky Flying Fish

Sculpture/Textiles

Students create awesome hanging fish sculptures using mesh, cane and pipe cleaners. A great tactile skill using fine-motor skills. Concepts – pattern, shape, balance.

Crazy Collographs

Printmaking

Students learn about the basics of printmaking, by making their own Print Block using Print Foam and Cardboard. Concepts – pattern, line, shape, texture.

Shape Colour Pattern

Printmaking

A fun busy activity with students creating two different types of mono-prints, and then mount their designs into a final creative art piece using paints and pastels. Concepts – Shape, colour, pattern.

Incredible Insects (Year 1 only)

Painting/Drawing

Following a series of simple instructions students create vibrant and striking insect artworks using charcoal, pastels and paints. Concepts – line, shape, colour, pattern.

7/8 Years

Wonderful Weaving

Sculpture/Textiles

using mesh and cane and other assorted media, students create fantastic creative hanging sculptures. A great tactile skill using fine-motor skills. Concepts – symmetry, pattern, colour.

Make Your Own Print Block

Printmaking

Using a range of media students create their own printblock, and print with it in various ways, and then use their prints to create a finished artwork. Concepts – Shape, texture, pattern, repetition

Fantastic Fairytales

Drawing/Collage

A fun creative lesson, with students creating magical fairytale artworks using paints pastels, and fairytale collage. Concepts – colour, line, pattern.

Funky Four Legged Friends

Sculpture/Mixed Media

A great sculpture activity with students creating their very own 3D critter. A wide range of resources are used including paints, felt, pattern paper and templates. Concepts – assemblage, construction, symmetry.



9/10 Years

Picasso Heads

Painting/Drawing

Students create their own Picasso masterpiece using paints charcoal and pastels. Concepts – Abstraction, pattern, line, shape, colour.

Complementary Colour Mobiles

Mixed Media

Using a range of 2D media and working with the colour wheel students create a funky hanging mobile. Various themes can be incorporated into this activity. Concepts – contrast, shape, design, abstraction, assemblage.

Postcard Prints

Printmaking

Using Print Foam, students design a creative postcard design, that they then print and turn into a postcard. Concepts – design, illustration.

3D Crazy Critters

Sculpture

Using a range of 2D media students work at making and constructing and decorating their 3D critter. Concepts – construction, assemblage, shape, colour, pattern, symmetry.

11/12 Years

White Lino Designs

Printmaking

A great safe medium for students to learn about printmaking. Students create a design to etch into their lino, and then print and mount into an interesting finished art piece. Concepts – shape, line, design, repetition, abstraction.

Groovy Moving Mobiles

Sculpture

A fun creative way to learn about the basics of sculpture. Students create 2D and 3D shapes using assorted paper and cardboard and then assemble and construct a hanging mobile. Concepts – symmetry, balance, pattern, shape, construction, assemblage, positive/negative space.

Awesome Insect Sculpture

Sculpture

Using a range of media including mesh, cane, wire students create awesome 3D insect sculptures. A great problem solving activity. Concepts – shape, form, assemblage, construction, symmetry.

Book Art

Mixed Media

Students create a small book in which they design words and illustrations for each page using a range of 2D media.. Various themes can be incorporated into this activity. Concepts – illustration, representational, non-representational, positive and negative space, design, assemblage.
