Mad Monster Murals

(Group Activity) - *PAINTING/DRAWING* - Students work in small groups to invent their very own crazy monster, using paints, charcoal, and pastels. This is a busy, fun activity allowing students to work on a large scale, work as a team, and use a variety of media. Children will be examining pattern and colour. End results are always impressive, and are great for bright displays in the classroom.

Core Concepts - *shape/colour/line* • Student Needs - *art shirts*

Making Moving Mobiles

SCULPTURE - Using a wide range of different 2D and 3D media, students will use their imagination to create a range of interesting and creative shapes, which will then be used to make a groovy moving mobile. Students will discover shape, colour, pattern, texture and balance. An awesome introduction to sculpture!

Core Concepts - *pattern/colour/shape/weaving/assemblage/balance/symmetry* • Student Needs - *scissors/glue sticks*

Marvelous Miro Masterpieces

(Year 1 Only) - *MIXED MEDIA* - The master artwork of Spanish artist Joan Miro will be used as inspiration for these fun, colorful artworks. Line, shape and colour will be the core concepts examined. Students will explore their imagination, while being introduced to mixed media techniques and processes.

Core Concepts - *colour/line/shape* • Student Needs - *art shirts*

Funny Clay Faces

CERAMICS/SCULPTURE - Students will love working with clay to create a slab base, and then learning how to make all of the features of their creative faces. Students will learn about the properties of clay, and also the basics of 3D sculpture.

Core Concepts - *shape/line/pattern/texture/modeling/assemblage* • Student Needs - *nil*

Ocean Art Murals **NEW**

(Group activity) - *PAINTING/DRAWING* - This is a fun group activity, with students working together in teams to create a magical, vibrant and colourful 'under the sea' masterpiece. Students will use charcoal/ pastels/ paints, and will discover some fun and effective drawing techniques.

Core concepts - *shape/line/colour/pattern* • Student needs - *art shirt/scissors*.

Sculpting Bits and Pieces **NEW**

SCULPTURE - These fun little sculptures will be enjoyed by everyone. Using a wide range of 3D media including clay and wire, students will be taken through a step by step process of modeling and assembling their fantastic 3D sculptures.

Core concepts - *line/shape/assemblage/balance/3D* • Student needs - *nil*

Forest Friends **NEW**

(Year 1 only) - *MIXED MEDIA* - This creative activity will have students designing and creating their very own forest animal stencils. Students will learn how to make an awesome artwork using their stencil designs, along with using other 2D media including paints/ markers/ pastels.

Core concepts - *shape/colour/pattern/texture* • Student needs - *art shirts/scissors/pencil*

Print Stamp Create! **NEW**

PRINTMAKING - This is a great lesson for students to learn all about printmaking. Students learn how to make a basic stencil, and a simple effective 'stamper' out of cardboard. Students will then use their printmaking skills to complete a vibrant striking artwork, that will be ready for display!

Core concepts - *shape/pattern/symmetry/colour* • Students needs - *art shirts/scissors/pencil*

Amazing Abstract Art

PAINTING - Students will discover a whole range of new concepts and media in this excellent step by step 2D painting activity. Students will learn about warm and cool colours, and positive and negative space, while using shape, line and pattern to create their abstract masterpieces. Results are sure to impress!!

Core Concepts - colour/shape/abstraction • Student Needs - scissors/glue sticks

Beautiful Bugs

PAINTING/DRAWING - The miniature creatures of the insect world never fail to fascinate, and these beautiful illustrations will do the same. Students will exercise their drawing skills, being taught how to use simple shape to build an image of an insect. This workshop also introduces students to basic watercolour painting techniques.

Core Concepts - line/shape/form/pattern/symmetry • Student Needs - pencils/glue sticks

Arty Australian Animals

MIXED MEDIA - Using a variety of 2D media including paints, pastels and charcoal, students will be creating an awesome Aboriginal-inspired masterpiece. We will be looking at lizards, turtles and fish, and will be using colours from nature. Students will love the process and will be proud of their fantastic finished designs.

Core Concepts - line/shape/colour/pattern • Student Needs - art shirts

Clay Cats and Dogs

CERAMICS - A fun lesson that is all about clay and sculpture, with students working at constructing a 3D cat or dog, with a creative fun edge. A great way to explore modeling and construction, with a fun tactile media. Students will absolutely love their new little clay pets!

Core Concepts - shape/form/construction/modeling/3D • Student Needs - nil

Clay Nature Mobiles **NEW**

SCULPTURE - This lesson combines a variety of media and skills, with children working towards creating a mix-media hanging sculpture inspired by Nature. Students will model various beads and shapes out of clay, and will work at assembling their own unique mobile, using wire and cane. These will look great on display in your classroom.

Core Concepts - shape/texture/balance/pattern/colour • Student Needs - scissors

My Family, My Community **NEW**

(Group Activity) - *PAINTING/DRAWING* - This activity will have students learning about the proportions of the face. Children will be working in small groups to create a large scale 'jig saw puzzle' of various faces of people they know from their family or community. With a multi-cultural focus, children will use a range of 2D media to create these fantastic murals.

Core Concepts - proportion/form/line/colour • Student Needs - art shirts

Oriental Stencils **NEW**

PRINTMAKING / MIX MEDIA - Learn about the beautiful art of the Orient, through the fun process of printmaking, stenciling and collage. Students will study the work of various artists from Japan and China, looking at their techniques, and distinct use of colour and imagery. Students will use this as inspiration to create their own Orient masterpieces.

Core Concepts - colour/shape/design/placement • Student Needs - scissors/glue sticks

Wicked Bird Sculptures **NEW**

CERAMICS - This is a great clay activity, with students working from a slab base, to create a fantastic bird sculpture. Students will learn how to use their clay in a variety of ways, to make their creative ceramic birds. Students will learn about form, shape, and texture. This workshop is a great introduction to 3D art.

Core Concepts - modeling/3D form/ texture/ form/ shape • Student Needs - nil

Picasso Heads

(Group or Individual activity) - *PAINTING/DRAWING* - Another of RAW Arts most popular art activities. We have been conducting this lesson in schools for over 10 years, and it always achieves excellent results. Students enjoy learning about the vibrant work of Pablo Picasso. Using his images as inspiration, children create their own masterpieces of bold, crazy Picasso portraits. A range of drawing and painting media will be used.

Core Concepts - colour/shape/line/pattern • Student Needs - nil

Mad Heads

CERAMICS/SCULPTURE - A fantastic 3D sculpture activity. Students are taken through a step by step process of constructing and modeling a head, neck and shoulders of a person, which they can then turn into whatever character they would like!. A great way to discover the properties of clay, with students creating imaginative and creative Mad Heads.

Core Concepts - modeling/3D form/ cartooning • Student Needs - nil

Photo Abstraction

PHOTO MEDIA/ MIXED MEDIA - Photographic paper and chemicals will be the chosen media to teach students the basics of 'camera-less' photography. Line/Pattern/Colour will be the focus of creating their vibrant and interesting abstract art works. A great technical lesson with fantastic results.

Core Concepts - abstraction/tone/colour/design • Student Needs - scissors/glue sticks

Surreal Figures

MIXED MEDIA - These impressive figurative illustrations will be inspired by the Surrealist movement and the students' imagination. A combination of collage, painting and drawing techniques will allow students to create a fascinating and polished small scale art work..

Core Concepts - surrealism/design/form • Student Needs - pencil/eraser/scissors/glue sticks

Little Junk Puppets

NEW

SCULPTURE - This is a workshop that requires a lot of imagination, and also some great problem solving skills. Students will use a wide range of 2D and 3D media to create a puppet style sculpture. We will be incorporating found objects and recycled media, along with wire and cardboard. Students will love their little creative characters!

Core Concepts - 3D construction/ assemblage/ balance/ symmetry • Student Needs - pencil/scissors/glue sticks

Cartooning

NEW

DRAWING/PAINTING - Looking at the various ways to create Cartoon characters is always a fun way to learn about art! Students will use a range of 2D media including markers and inks to develop and create their own individual character. This activity will put a smile on everyone's face!

Core Concepts - form/colour/line/stylisation • Student Needs - pencil/eraser

Creative Clay Insects

NEW

CERAMICS - Students will be taken through a step by step process of manipulating and modeling their clay, to create the various body parts of an insect. They will then decorate their insect in different ways, and will be able to incorporate other media into their final piece. These sculptures will be sure to impress!

Core Concepts - 3D form/ construction/ modeling/ shape/ texture/ symmetry • Student Needs - nil

Decorative Print Art

NEW

PRINTMAKING - Looking at decorative shapes and pattern, students will develop a design for their very own printblock. Students will then be taken through a printing process, which will require students to use their printblock in a number of different ways, to create different effects. A technical lesson, with awesome results.

Core Concepts - positive and negative shape/ design/ symmetry • Student Needs - scissors/glue sticks

Mombassa Murals

NEW

(Group Activity) - This is a fun group activity inspired by the vibrant work of Mambo artist Reg Mombassa. We will be looking at a number of his quirky paintings of stylised animals/buildings/urban landscapes. Students will work in small groups to create their own large scale Mombassa masterpieces, using charcoal, pastels, paints and collage media. These will be great for classroom display.

Core Concepts - colour/shape/line/tone/design • Student Needs - art shirts

Terracotta Totems

CERAMICS/ SCULPTURE - Drawing on pre-existing examples students will invent and build their very own ceramic totem. Basic clay hand building techniques will be taught to create a unique contemporary take on an ancient and symbolic form of sculpture.

Core Concepts - 3D form/ construction/ modeling/ shape/ texture • Student Needs - nil

Abstract Prints and Stamps

PRINTMAKING - This workshop will involve a wide range of non-traditional printmaking media. We will be exploring different ways that prints can be made using texture. We will also be looking at repetition/ pattern/ colour/ shape/ design. Students will create some great printing effects, which will then be incorporated into a finished abstract artwork. Lots of fun!

Core Concepts - shape/colour/texture/pattern/ symmetry • Student Needs - scissors/glue sticks

Painting the Aussie Outback

PAINTING - Using the famous Australian landscape artist Fred Williams as inspiration, we will be creating a beautiful outback scene using both traditional and non-traditional painting media. We will explore colour theory and colour mixing, to help us discover the process of creating tone and texture within a painting. A great technique based lesson, with fantastic results.

Core Concepts - texture/colour/tone/ space • Student Needs - art shirts/scissors

Looking @ Keith Haring?

(Group Activity) - **MIXED MEDIA** - Pop artist Keith Haring is famous for his playful and bold simple designs of figures. Using his artwork as inspiration the concepts of colour, line, shape and also gesture and movement will be examined. Students will work with various 2D media to create firstly their own individual figure, and will then work as a group to create a large scale Pop Art masterpiece.

Core Concepts - colour/stylization/design/balance • Student Needs - scissors

Cool Car Constructions

NEW

(Group Activity) - **SCULPTURE** - This workshop is all about construction and team work! Looking at the work of a number of sculptors, students will work together in small groups to create a large-scale sculpture of a car. This will require problem solving skills, and team effort. Students will then work at personalizing their cars with stencil work, and detailing. Students will use a wide range of media, and will be excited by this fun process of construction and sculpting.

Core Concepts - 3D form/ construction/assemblage/shape/texture • Student Needs - scissors

Zig Zag Zines

NEW

MIXED MEDIA - 'Zines' are the latest in self published magazines and comics. Students will get to create their own personal zine, using a range of different 2D media. Classes can choose between a 'street art' 'pop art' and 'surrealist' theme. Students will be shown a range of thematic images to inspire, and they will then be guided towards creating a 6-page zine, full of creativity, imagination and fun - using images/text/drawing/stamping/collage/stenciling.

Core Concepts - design/placement/colour/line/illustration • Student Needs - pencil/scissors/glue sticks

Clay Reduction Tile

NEW

CERAMICS - This is a simple, but effective ceramic lesson, with students creating a thick slab, in which they will be etching, scratching and removing clay from, to create their patterned design. This will then be used as a base to create a 'wall hanging' style art piece, incorporating other media such as wire/ plastic thread and beading.

Core Concepts - 3D form/ reduction/pattern/texture/design • Student Needs - nil

Funky Font Prints

NEW

PRINTMAKING - Students will use their name as inspiration for this art piece. Looking at a wide range of different styles of popular Fonts, students will create a name design that they will then be making into a stencil. We will then take the students through a simple and effective mono-print technique, to create their funky font images.

Core Concepts - shape/colour/positive and negative shape/ design • Student Needs - pencil/erase/scissors/glue sticks

Looking @ Illustration

NEW

DRAWING/PAINTING - This workshop focuses on the art of illustration. Looking at some famous and popular illustrators, and their styles and techniques, students will develop their own character, based on a series of body stencils. Students will be using markers and watercolour paints to create their creative characters. This is a fun lesson requiring lots of imagination!

Core Concepts - line/tone/colour/shape/form/illustration • Student Needs - pencil/eraser/scissors/glue sticks
